WITHIN TENSION is the seventh studio album from Ross Neilsen. The album captures Neilsen's gritty, soulful Northern blues through a new lens. The album was born over four days at the historic Sam Phillips Recording Services with a handpicked crew of top-tier Memphis musicians. The album contains ten tracks that blend high-octane blues rock with raw, emotional storytelling. The album was produced by Neilsen with Memphis music heavyweights Kevin Houston and John C. Stubblefield. The album features sonic contributions from Lucero's Rick Steff (Keys), aforementioned Stubblefield (Bass) and Jay Sheffield III (Drums). Two of the standout tracks also feature the horn section of Marc Franklin and Art Edmaiston (Gregg Allman Band, Little Feat). All tracks were written or co-written by Neilsen with the exception of one cover from blue-eyed, soul master, Eddie Hinton. The ten-track collection explores themes of mental health, identity, isolation and belonging.
